FAIR is an intensive home and community-based program designed for parents experiencing challenges related to parenting, substance use, and mental health problems. FAIR is strengths-based and trauma-informed.

FAIR Implementation Support



Average length of treatment: 9 months

Average caseload size: 7-10 per clinician

**Pre-implementation involves completion of cost and capacity calculator to optimize team size based on agency and regional characteristics, and Medicaid billing structure*

Operational Needs for Implementation:

- Urinalysis protocol and CLIA-waived test certificate
- 24 on-call protocol/staffing
- State approval for service delivery in community
- [Preferred] SUDS and BH licensure
- DHS/Child Welfare support and communication
- HIPAA training
- Phone policy
- Mileage/Provision of services in community
- Ability to transport clients
- Medicaid or other method for reimbursement

Approximate Annual Cost:

Year 1: \$77,500

Year 2: \$46,000

Year 3: \$28,500

Additional Agency Resource Needs:

- FAIR Store
 - Physical space needed
 - Stocked with donations
 - Provides reinforcement for safe and sober households
 - Provides *in vivo* learning for budgeting
- Clinical session expenses
 - Coffee/beverage
 - Snack
 - Small incentives

FAIR's implementation approach is developed using standardized implementation strategies. FAIR uses the Stages of Implementation Completion (www.oslc.org/sic).
